


Book Bank

Computer Laboratory

Pharmaceutics Laboratory

Equipped with different instruments like propellers, agitators, stirrers, water baths, mantles, filling and sealing machines, melting point apparatus, hot plates, oven, desiccators, stability chamber etc. is one truly practical lab for gaining practical experiences.



Pharmaceutical Chemistry Laboratory

The laboratory is continuously engaged for various experiments of synthesis of drugs to explore possibilities of finding newer molecules of therapeutic importance. Holds instruments like synthesis assemblies, distillation assembly, microwave ovens, hot plates, oil and water baths, MR apparatus, mantles etc. Also contained with chemicals and reagents of practical use.

Pharmacognosy Laboratory

The subject deals with study of crude drugs of plant origin. Their characterization, extraction methods, isolation of essentials etc. The lab holds various instruments as extraction assemblies, incinerators, heating mantles, grinders, soakers, desiccators etc. Numerous charts showing L.S., T.S. of plants, their morphological appearance are also hanged over.



Pharmacology Laboratory

This subject studies in regards to various animals to test them for activities of different synthetic as well as plant origin drugs. Laboratory is equipped with instruments of prime importance.

Anatomy & Physiology Laboratory

Study of anatomy and physiology of human beings is of great importance as far as pharmaceutical sciences are concerned. Here various models showing human anatomical features are kept. Various charts showing different systems in human body are displayed.



Animal House

This houses animals like Mice, Rats, Rabbits, Frogs, Guinea pigs to work on them of different experimental studies under the schemes of Pharmacology. This is of its own class and standard and is the unique in the university.

Language Laboratory

Admission Details - Eligibility Criteria

Candidates willing to secure admission to any of the following courses will have to fulfill the stipulated eligibility criteria and undergo Centralized Admission Process (CAP).

Admission Procedure

Admission to D. Pharmacy, B. Pharmacy & M. Pharmacy are strictly done as per the rules & regulations of Government of Maharashtra & Director of Technical Education. These guidelines will be available on the website of the College www.rgiop.com as & when published by concerned authorities.

Fees Structure

The annual Tuition Fees and other fees shall be as prescribed by the Fees Regulating Authority, & Fee Fixation Committee, Government of Maharashtra. The admitted candidates will have to pay the fees in a single installment at the time of admission. No part payment shall be accepted.

All the fees should be paid in cash or by all type of online mode in favor of "The Principal, Dr. Rajendra Gode Institute of Pharmacy, Amravati."

Concession in Fees

1) Concession to candidates belonging to SC/ST/VJ/NT/SBC category

The candidates belonging to SC/ST/VJ/NT/SBC category will get 100% concession Fee in Tuition Fees. They will have to pay only the University Fee, Development

2) Concession to candidates belonging to OBC category

The candidates belonging to Other Backward Class category will get 50% concession in Tuition Fees. They will have to pay the remaining fees by their own.

3) Candidates belonging to EBC / SEBC / EWS category

The candidates belonging to Economically Backward Class category also can avail the benefits of concession in Tuition Fees as per the regulations of Government of Maharashtra.



Refund of Fees after cancellation of admission


The candidates who have been provisionally admitted may cancel admission by submitting application in the prescribed proforma and may request for refund of fees. However, such cancellation and refund of fees will be strictly as per the rules and regulations stipulated by government of Maharashtra

Important Academic Rules

1. Every student should always carry personal identity card issued by the institute.
2. College Uniform is also compulsory which shows harmony among students.
3. As per the university & PCI New Delhi norms 80% attendance in theory, Practical and tutorial, completion of term work is compulsory Students having less than 80% of attendance will be detained (they will not be allowed to appear for examination.)
4. Students are not permitted to form any association, society & organisation in college premises.
5. It will be the duty of the students to read notices regarding rules, regulation and schedule for the activities like submission of examination form, starting of classes etc. on notice board / website daily.
6. Every association / club/ council / organisation etc. shall be formed under the sponsorship of the college under the privilege of a faculty member nominated by the principal. Student shall obtain relevant notices applications etc. only through the faculty.
7. Institution runs Mentor Mentee scheme. All the students must contact and attend weekly meeting with their respected Mentor. Parents must also be in Contact with the teacher Mentor.

Action Against Ragging....


Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May 1999 has the following provisions for action against Ragging.

- a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- b) Those who ever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and/or penalty which may extend to Ten Thousand Rupees.
- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institute for a period of 5 years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provision, within seven days of the receipt of complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institute is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he/she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of institution shall be final.
- e) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

Rules for scholarship

Applicants from Scheduled Castes, Various Backward Classes and Economically Backward Classes who have secured and confirmed their final admission can avail the benefit under State Government various Scholarship/ Freeship scheme etc. by applying online through State Government <http://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in/portal>.

For availing the prescribed benefit of scholarship/Freeship schemes, etc. The candidate must fulfil the scheme eligibility and submit online application through Maha-DBT portal within one month from the date of securing final admission in the college/institution.
